

SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

As part of the identity of Ecole Ruban Vert, all students are required to adhere to the school Uniform Policy as set out below. Students who report to school inappropriately attired may be removed from class and their parents contacted.

Non-uniform days

The Headmaster will announce non-uniform days. Students shall be permitted to dress as they choose on non-uniform days providing the attire is clean, tidy and appropriate (as per guidelines below). Non-uniform days.

Non-uniform Dress Code

- No spaghetti straps or tank tops
- No cut-off jeans
- Mid riffs must be covered
- No see-through clothing
- No offensive logos or slogans
- Skirt length must not be any shorter than mid-thigh
- No muscle shirts
- No other items that staff feel inappropriate

Jewellery

Is not to be worn during the school day except for one pair of stud earrings for girls, if they wish to do so. Exceptions only apply for religious reasons and must be arranged through the Head of School (Primary or Secondary). Other jewellery will be confiscated.
