All secondary students need to have a scientific calculator.

This should not have a graphic display and should not offer algebraic manipulation.

The Casio fx-83 GT is ideal. The Casio fx-92 is not.

For students in Year 9/10/11: your calculator should have Trig Functions: Sin, Cos, Tan

For students in Year 12/13: you need a Graphing Calculator TI nspire cx
