CALCULATOR GUIDANCE - for all Secondary students

All students in Years 7-11 need to have a basic scientific calculator. This should not have a graphic display and should not offer algebraic manipulation. The Casio fx-83 GT is ideal. The Casio fx-92 is not.

For students in Year 9/10/11: your calculator should have Trig Functions: Sin, Cos, Tan

For students in Year 12/13: you need a Graphing Calculator: TI nSpire CX (non-CAS) or TI-84. NB: the nSpire CX can be purchased from the boutique at ERV.

SPECIALIST EQUIPMENT - ART

All students in Years 7/8/9 and IGCSE & IB Art students:

- Sketchbooks 1X green and 1X blue *Dessin Calligraphie Ligne 7000 48pgs 120gsm*
- A3 size Canson paper 180gsm
- Shading pencils 2B, 4B, 6B box
- White eraser (*Staedler*)
- Colour pencils (min 12 colours)
- Oil pastel box (min 12 colours)
- Pilot marker pen black ink extra fine
- Fineliner black ink
- Watercolour box (min 12 colours)
- Set of brushes (fine, medium & wash) NB: please ensure these are round, flat, sable hair brushes.
- Small mixing palette

In addition, for students taking IGCSE or IBDP Art (Years 10/11/12/13):

- Gouache paints (min 12 colours)
- Acrylic paints (min 12 colours)
- A packet of oil paints (min 12 colours)
- A tube of white oil Paint (300ml)
- Set of chalk pastels (min 12 colours)
- Set of coloured gel pens (including white if possible)
- Box of charcoal
- A2 size cardboard folder for storing artwork

In addition, for students taking IBDP Art in (Years 12/13):

- 1x A3 black hard-backed ring bound sketchbook
- Gel pens or sketch pens

SPECIALIST EQUIPMENT - ICT

All students in Year 7 & Year 8:

- 1x Microbit v2, 1x USB lead, 1x battery pack, 1 pack of AAA batteries.
