

## Information Communication Technology (ICT)

In the PYP, the ever-increasing impact of Information and Communication Technologies on teaching and learning is recognized. The use of technologies is integrated as much as possible into student inquiries.

ICT provides opportunities for the enhancement of learning, and may significantly support students in their inquiries, and in developing their conceptual understanding. At ERV, technology is considered as a tool for learning, albeit with its own set of skills, as opposed to an additional subject area.

The uses of ICT at ERV include:

- documentation of the learning, making it available to all parties
- providing opportunities for rapid feedback and reflection
- providing opportunities to enhance authentic learning
- providing access to a broad range of sources of information
- providing students with a range of tools to store, organise and present their learning
- encouraging communication with a wide-ranging audience
